What has changed?

The rules around face coverings have changed.



You need to wear a face covering in shops, on public transport and some other business such as banks and hairdressers.



You do not need to wear face coverings in hospitality venues such as pubs and restaurants.



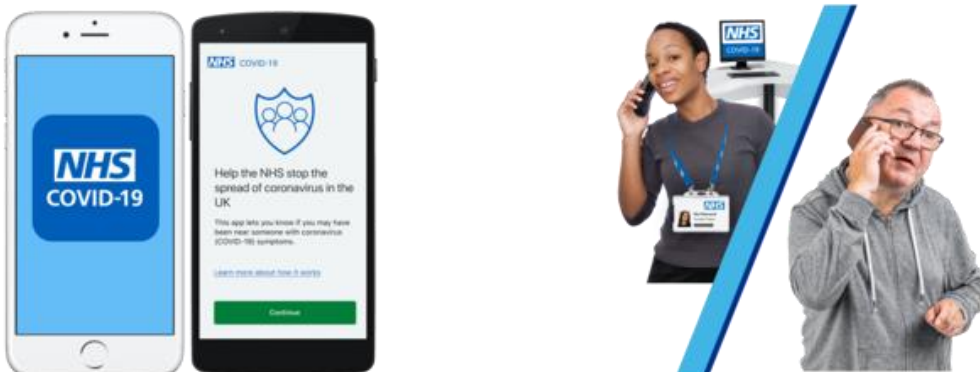


Other changes

People arriving in the country from abroad, must take a PCR test and self isolate until they receive their result.



All contacts of suspected Omicron cases must self isolate, even if they are fully vaccinated. They will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace.
